# 7th International Conference on History (His 2024): Shaping the Future of Historical Research



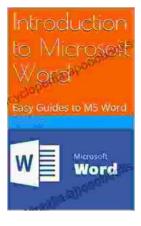

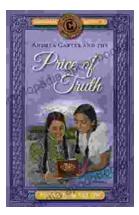
