In her description of her father's devotion to his English hat, Kincaid captures the insidious way in which English superiority had worked its way into her father's sense of himself. Her father adopted a hat entirely ill-suited for the Caribbean climate because "he must have admired a picture of an Englishman wearing such a hat in England." Kincaid offers no other details about her father, implying that his pursuit of a proper English image, like the hat that "became so central to his character," supplanted other aspects of his personality.

At the end of the second paragraph, Kincaid levels what is perhaps her most serious and sarcastic indictment of England's imperial reach: "Almost everything" except "the sea, the sky, and

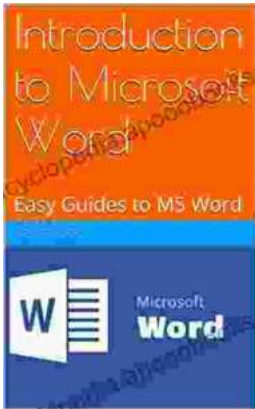

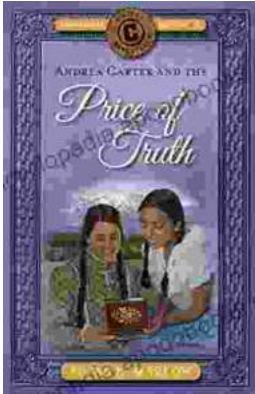
